A Thought From Mark...

2 Timothy 4:7 – “I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith; in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.”

On October 25, the Figueroa Church of Christ in Los Angeles sang:

"I'm a hard-fighting soldier on the battlefield" before Darrell Holt began his sermon.

As he concluded his sermon, he said, "Enough happened on the cross to make me happy for a lifetime," then, "I need to sit down."

Looking toward heaven from the front row, he motioned for the song leader to rise and continued, "Jesus wants his people to be happy. If you're not a Christian, say yes to him. You've heard the Word. Believe it. Repent of your sins, confess Christ, and be baptized!"

As the congregation sang, he became unresponsive. In spite of CPR given by three church members who were nurses, he was pronounced dead at the hospital of a heart attack.

Faithful until death...

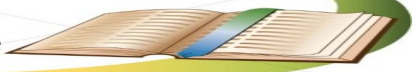
Revelation 2:10
