### LYN: Next Door This Year

Jesus said, "And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" Jesus thought living this way was very important. As Jesus' followers, we want to live everyday doing what He thought was important. Can you imagine what it would be like if Christians became known as the best next door neighbors?

## Where Do I Start?

Describing our Savior, Matthew 9:36 says, "When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd." When we realize our responsibility to share the gospel with the lost, it may be easy to become overwhelmed by the sheer number of people around us who need to hear it.

We wonder how we can make a difference. The answer is - one soul at a time! Again Jesus is our perfect example. In Luke 19 Christ was passing through Jericho, surrounded by yet another pressing crowd of people. But Jesus was not distracted by the crowd. There was one man there who was ready to hear the message of Jesus. Verse 5: "And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, 'Zaccheus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today.'"
