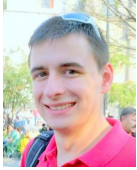

Dinner will be provided as well.


