**A Thought From Mark...**

I ran across a quote the other day that made me sit back a minute and think – “How regrettable that we often forget what God remembers and remember what God forgets.” I tried to think about some of the things in both of those categories that might apply to us. The first is easier than the second.

Things God remembers that we forget:

- His precious promises to us.
- Things we have prayed and He has answered.
- His holy words.
- How much He loves us every moment of our lives.
- Our promises and pledges and vows.

All of these, and many more, are so easy for us to forget. But God always remembers them all!

Things God forgets that we remember:

- Our sins that He has forgiven.

I am not sure there is anything else in this category – but how important is this one!! We ought to have memorized and never forgotten Jeremiah 31:34! In that passage God promises a coming new covenant that we now enjoy in Christ – a covenant not written on stone but on our hearts. And key to that covenant is verse 34, where God says, *“And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.”*

In our struggle to achieve godliness, we ought to strive to remember what God remembers and forget what God forgets.
