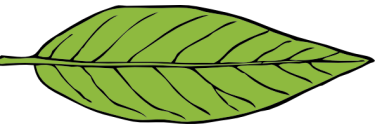

- Andrew Smith (former student of Mary Beth Full) has some of his sight back.

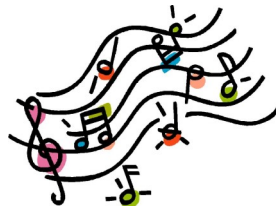
