Zacchaeus Was a Wee Little Man. By Michael Moss

**TODAY'S SCRIPTURE::** Luke 19:1-10

I remember as a wee little lad singing, "Zacchaeus was a wee little man, and a wee little man was he." It wasn't until much later that the song and the story took on real meaning.

The man who wants to see Jesus is not blind man but an outcast of a different sort. His name is Zacchaeus, and he is a chief tax collector. He probably collected customs charged for those transporting goods.

Tax collectors were despised by most Jews. Zacchaeus would have been considered in cohorts with the Romans and would have been deemed a traitor. This tax collector wealthy which makes him unlikely candidate for faith.

Wanting to see Jesus but being too short to see over crowds, Zacchaeus demonstrates great resolve by climbing a sycamore-fig tree along road Jesus traveling. His behavior was undignified.

How Jesus knew Zacchaeus' name is not explained. Jesus commanded, "**Hurry . . . down, for I must stay at your house today.**" When Jesus invites himself to visit with Zacchaeus at his house, Zacchaeus was delighted.

After the people saw this, they were grumbling, the standard refrain disapproval. "**He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner.**"

It would seem that Zacchaeus has heard the grumbling. The implication may well be that Zacchaeus repents and accepts teaching of Jesus regarding poor.

Zacchaeus promises to give half of his possessions to poor. Zacchaeus' repentance is made clear when he offers, if he has cheated anyone, to pay back four times the amount.

Earlier Jesus ha said, "With God all things are possible. It is possible for a rich man to enter the kingdom." Now this is proven to be true.

Having witnessed his repentance, Jesus declares, "**Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham.**" God is reigning in this man's life.

Jesus give His rationale for associating with outcasts. "**For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.**"
