Holy, Holy Holy

Holy, Holy, Holy has been sung in churches around the world since the 1800s. It has been recorded by everyone from Bing Crosby to Ronnie Milsap, and for good reason. The inspiring words are the work of Reginald Heber (1783–1826), an Anglican Bishop of Calcutta. They were a part of the lectures Heber delivered at the Oxford's Bampton Lectures for 1815, emphasizing the deity of the Holy Spirit. In celebration of Trinity Sunday (1861), John Bacchus Dykes (1823-1876) wrote the tune, *Nicaea*, to which the words are commonly sung.

Isaiah had an amazing vision in the temple that would change his life. Whatever else takes place in heaven, the six-winged seraphim proclaim in chorus to one another with love and adoration for God: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!" (Isaiah 6:1-3).

Nearly a thousand years later, after the Son of God had made atonement for our sins, John experienced his own sweeping vision of heaven while on the isle of Patmos. Again, there was the familiar refrain: "Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!" (Revelation 4:8b).

We must understand that we are never to stop singing and saying, "Holy, holy, holy is LORD God."
