"Let love be genuine ... *Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep*" Romans 12:9-15.

My family has both rejoiced and wept this past week. Just seven days ago from when I'm writing this, the entire family came over for family dinner time on Tuesday. That never happens. My late wife's 84 year-old father, whose health had been failing, was strong enough to get up the stairs from his lower-level living space in our home to visit, eat with us, and interact with his great-grandson, who's not yet two. On Thursday his great-granddaughter was born, and on Friday evening he held her in the hospital. On Saturday morning he went by ambulance to the ER and then to the ICU. On Sunday afternoon he went onto palliative care and then passed away by evening.

Job lamented, "*The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.*" So many brothers and sisters at church last Sunday morning were congratulating us about Thursday's news while expressing concern about Saturday's uncertainty. "*The household of faith*" (Galatians 6:10 ESV) indeed wrapped us up in genuine love. The NIV describes us as "*the family of believers*" ... or "God's Family." That song captures the love we have for our blood-bought brethren:

We're part of the family that's been born again; Part of the family whose love knows no end; For Jesus has saved us, and made us His own, Now we're part of the family that's on its way home.

When a brother meets sorrow we all feel his grief; When he's passed thro' the valley we all feel relief; Together in sunshine, together in rain, Together in vict'ry thro' His precious name.

And tho' some go before us, we'll all meet again; Just inside the city as we enter in; There'll be no more parting with Jesus we'll be Together forever, God's family.

Chorus: And sometimes we laugh together, sometimes we cry; Sometimes we share together, heartaches and sighs; Sometimes we dream together of how it will be When we all get to Heaven, God's family.
