May 25, 1924, ninety-nine years ago this past week, a small group of believers in Vienna held a dedication service for the newly-formed Pleasant Avenue Church of Christ in a little white building on the 34th & 7th corner of our lot today. Ilene Lemley's mother was among them. And, though they were very young then, so were Ellen (Bill) Phillips Newbern and Betty Ann Miller, who were the last living attendees from that service and were honored at our 75th in 1999. Their parents were charter members, Letha Price and Curt & Rose Miller. Curt (SC) Miller served as one of our first elders in 1946 for four decades when one of our current elders, Terry Garner, began serving along with him in 1985.

And thus, one of the many bridges of our rich history is made from the beginning to the start of our 100th year today! The Centennial Committee is busy with lots of plans throughout the year to honor 36th Street's past and envision our future. These will culminate at a banquet at Grand Pointe on **May 25, 2024**, one hundred years to the day of our dedication, after a month-long celebration.

That's about then ... what about now? Memorial Day weekend means that school is out for another year. Families will be coming and going on vacations, and our kids are studying the Life of Christ. This Wednesday will bring the return of a quarterly Question Night while the 'Lunch Bunch' begins a monthly cooking class. Quite a lineup of preachers will come through on Wednesdays for the next thirteen weeks for our "What's the Good News?" summer series while on Sundays the adults will take a 'big picture' look at the Life of David.

So, while reminiscing about the church's 'glory days' in decades past, we will take this season to make new memories with the church of the present as we enjoy cookouts, singing nights, Widows Walk trips—all in the fellowship of our brothers and sisters in Christ. This we'll do as we lay the foundation for future generations to serve here.
