A Ship Tossed Upon Stormy Seas

Alfred Noyes' "The Highwayman" begins this way: *The wind was a torrent of darkness among the gusty trees. The moon was a ghostly galleon tossed upon cloudy seas.* Besides being a great example of metaphor in poetry for my English students, these words work well to describe the church in this troubled time—especially in late fall when it's darker earlier, most of the trees are bare, and there's a chill in the air.

We're uneasy as we peer through the porthole of our TVs and see the storm's chaos streaming on our phones. We cling ever tighter to something solid in the belly of the ship, the church, while the wind and waves crash around us, threatening to swamp us. That something solid, of course, is Christ, and, rather than an oil lamp that must be doused to keep the ship from catching fire, He is the light of the world piercing the darkness all around.

More than a metaphor for the church, though, God used an actual vessel to save lives: *"...God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. Baptism which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ" 1 Peter 3:20-21.* Today, all but those who are aboard the ark of the Lord's "one body" (Ephesians 4:5) are drowning in the floodwaters; it's just that they do not know it!

Elders, preachers, and teachers help to steer each local ship and chart its course while the deacons and other ministry leaders are the deckhands to encourage all passengers to conduct their work amid the storm. Because, you see, this is no pleasure cruise that we're on. It's "all hands on deck" as we minister to one another and perhaps pull a few of the drowning from the water and wreckage around us with the life ring of the gospel and together find our safe harbor.
