One Tribe Lacking on the Eve of the Centennial

In less than a month, we will begin a month-long celebration of our century of service in Vienna with many events and speakers. The marker of a centennial is large enough to make us reflect on how we have gotten to where we are and pause to ponder on how we will continue into the next 100 years. Today we begin the fourth month of a study of the Lord's church—so we can be what God intended us to be as revealed in His Word.

And today we have our last sermon from Judges in the era of *"everyone did what was right in his own eyes."* Their own sin and spiritual drift had caused the compromise of God's commands that led to rash vows and the decimation of Benjamin ... that led to their weeping and questioning God why there was *"one tribe lacking in Israel?"* This too was a time for reflection.

But this was not what they did. It does not say that they went to God in prayer about their concerns about what they had done that led to this time nor about their future as God's treasured possession. Neither do we see them inquiring of the LORD about what they ought to do nor a renewing of their covenant with Him. Instead, they took action from their own counsel, it seems, to find wives for Benjamin ... the tribe that Saul, the first king that they rejected God by demanding (1 Samuel 8), would later come from.

Do we have at least one tribe lacking? Census information shows that 75% of any religious group is made up of Boomers, who are centered in their 70s right now. Where are our Gen-Xers, Millennials, Gen-Zs, and new Gen-Alphas—whose attendance has dropped off with each generation? Do we bear any responsibility for that? Can we do anything to change that and lay a foundation for them for the future of the Lord's church?

Not making the mistakes of God's people in Judges, we must hold fast to His Word and lean not on our own understanding.
